

FCTC Annual Meeting
January 14, 2010

The meeting was called to order by President Margie Cain at 7:45 pm.

The turnout for this meeting was disappointing, but business was taken care of.

Three show proposals were presented to the membership for discussion. They were:

- 1) "The Maltese Falcon", a radio theatre presentation. This was proposed by Peter Harrington as a Spring show, to be performed at the BFA in Fairfax on April 29 thru May 1. The approved budget was \$800.
- 2) "Narnia the Musical" was proposed by San Harrington. A Summer show, the performances are to be July 15-17 at First Congregational Church in St. Albans, and July 22-24 at First Baptist Church in Burlington. The approved budget was \$4740.
- 3) "The Curious Savage" as the Fall show was proposed by Jerry Starks. It is to be performed at the Westford Brick Meeting House September 29 thru October 2. The approved budget was \$1601.

After some discussion, the membership approved the season as proposed. It was brought up that everyone needs to promote participation in all of the shows as well as promoting attendance. Apparently all local theatre groups are having difficulty recruiting participants, so we all need to pull together.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00 pm.
